Sedation and General Anesthesia Consent Form

Your pet is scheduled to undergo sedation or general anesthesia. While almost all animals do very well, there is **always some degree of risk associated with any anesthesia**. At Sand Lake Animal Clinic we take several steps to minimize these risks and protect the health of your pet.

These include:

- 1. **All** animals receive a physical examination and pre-anesthetic evaluation.
- 2. **All** sedation and general anesthesia is administered only by licensed veterinarians.
- 3. **All** animals undergo minor blood screening tests to detect underlying health problems that may complicate anesthesia. These tests are performed at no additional charge.
- 4. Sick animals, animals with abnormal results from minor screening tests, and animals middle-aged or older (see chart below) undergo major blood screening tests to evaluate their major organ systems before anesthesia. There is a fee of \$273.00 for this service.
